AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to fraternity and sorority residential houses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 7, Part 1, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated section:

49-7-124. If an institution of higher education in this state permits a fraternity to locate and maintain a residential house on the campus of such institution, then such institution shall not prohibit a sorority from locating and maintaining a residential house on the campus of such institution. Any rules applying to a sorority house shall be no less stringent than those applying to a fraternity house.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
