AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-14-207; Section 6-56-307 and Section 12-3-217, relative to purchases of chemical products.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-14-207, is amended by deleting the current language in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

- (a) Bid specifications for purchases of chemical products pursuant to this chapter shall require that the manufacturer of the chemical products create and maintain a material safety data sheet (MSDS) for such chemical products on the national MSDSSEARCH repository or the manufacturer's website so that the information can be accessed by means of the internet. A site operated by or on behalf of the manufacturer or a relevant trade association is acceptable so long as the information is freely accessible to the public.
- (b) The URL for MSDSSEARCH shall be posted on the website of the department of general services as provided in section 12-3-217. In lieu of posting a MSDS on MSDSSEARCH, a bidder shall include the manufacturer's URL for their MSDS in the bid proposal or purchase order.
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 6-56-307, is amended by deleting the current language in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:
 - (a) Bid specifications for purchases of chemical products pursuant to this chapter shall require that the manufacturer of the chemical products create and maintain a material safety data sheet (MSDS) for such chemical products on the national MSDSSEARCH repository or the manufacturer's website so that the information can be accessed by means of the internet. - (a) Bid specifications for purchases of chemical products pursuant to this chapter shall require that the manufacturer of the chemical products create and maintain a material safety data sheet (MSDS) for such chemical products on the national MSDSSEARCH repository or the manufacturer's website so that the information can be accessed by means of the internet. A site operated by or on behalf of the manufacturer or a relevant trade association is acceptable so long as the information is freely accessible to the public. In lieu of posting a MSDS on MSDSSEARCH, a bidder shall include the manufacturer's URL for their MSDS in the bid proposal or purchase order.
- (b) The commissioner of general services shall post on it's website the universal resource locator (URL) for MSDSSEARCH which is currently http://www.msdssearch.com. The commissioner shall update such URL if necessary.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
