

## CHAPTER NO. 710

## HOUSE BILL NO. 2875

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102, relative to consumption of alcoholic beverages in a premier type tourist resort located off I-75 and Highway 68 in any county having a population of not less than thirty-eight thousand nine hundred (38,900) nor more than thirty-nine thousand (39,000) according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(24), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision (O) and by redesignating present subdivision (O) as subdivision (P):

(O) A commercially operated facility which contains all of the following characteristics:

(i) Such facility is located no more than one half (1/2) mile from the right of way of Interstate 75 and accessible to state highway 68;

(ii) Such facility has at least nine thousand (9,000) square feet of conference space;

(iii) Such facility provides accommodations consisting of at least one hundred twenty-five (125) hotel or motel rooms in a building or buildings designed for such purposes;

(iv) Such facility provides recreational facilities including an indoor swimming pool;

(v) Such facility does not discriminate against any patron on the basis of age, gender, sexual orientation, race, religion or national origin; and

(vi) Such facility is located within a county having a population of not less than thirty-eight thousand nine hundred (38,900) nor more than thirty-nine thousand (39,000), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it
