- (1) The Commission will hold at least one regularly scheduled meeting during each calendar quarter.
- (2) At each meeting, the Commission shall establish the date, time and location for the next meeting.
- (3) The meeting will be conducted in accordance with *Roberts Rules of Order* upon a written agenda.
- (4) Minutes will be made of each meeting and approved at the next meeting.
